# Conference Housing Guest Information University of Nevada, Las Vegas

# Arrival Information to UNLV Conference Housing Check-In (Tonopah Hall):

- Directions from McCarran International Airport: Exit the airport via Swenson Street. Turn right on Tropicana Avenue and proceed east two blocks on Tropicana to Maryland Parkway. Turn left on Maryland Parkway and proceed north to University Road (first red light) and turn left onto University Road. Drive straight down University Road and pass one stop sign. Make a right at the second stop sign. Tonopah Hall is the large six-story building on your right hand side. Enter through the double doors in the center of the building.
- Directions from Interstate 15: Exit I-15 at the Tropicana Avenue East Exit. Follow Tropicana Avenue (approximately 3 miles) and turn left on Maryland Parkway. Follow the same directions as listed above to the Conference Housing Office.
- Directions from US Highway 93 & 95: Exit the Tropicana Avenue West exit and continue on Tropicana Avenue (approximately 6 miles) to Maryland Parkway. Turn right onto Maryland Parkway and follow the directions as listed above.




- Conference Housing Office Your stay with Conference Housing at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas will begin with check-in at our Year-Round Conference Housing building. Tonopah Hall (#35 on the map) is located at 1130 University Road. Tonopah Hall houses the main Conference Housing Office. Enter campus from Maryland Parkway at University Road. Drive straight down University Road and pass two stop signs. Make a right at the second stop sign. Tonopah Hall is the large six-story building your right. Use the entrance on the northwest corner of the complex. (NOTE: Summer groups should check with their conference coordinator on exact check-in location)
- Check-in Information Check-in is between 8:00am and 11:00pm. If your group is expected to arrive after hours please contact your conference coordinator ahead of time to make check-in arrangements. If only a few individuals are expected to arrive outside of the above hours, please have the guests contact the Conference Housing on-call contact number (702) 429-8060 upon arrival on campus. (NOTE: Check-in hours are subject to change)

Parking - You must have a valid parking permit to park on campus. Parking permits are available for purchase at the 0 Conference Housing Office during guest check-in. Prices are determined based on the guest's length of stay. Please see your conference coordinator if you would like to provide/pay for all parking permits for your guests. They can be handed to each guest or on-site contact upon check-in. Guests may park (with a permit) in several designated lots around campus. Specific lots and detailed parking instructions will be available by the Conference Housing staff at the time of guest check-in. This may include the parking lot adjacent to the Residence Halls, the Student Union parking lot, or the lot adjacent to the Thomas & Mack Center. All buses or large vehicles must park in the Thomas & Mack parking lot (M Lot). Please do not park in reserved parking areas or spaces marked for faculty and staff. The Conference Housing Office assumes no responsibility for any parking tickets received while on the UNLV Campus.

- Housekeeping Housekeeping services are provided in public hallways, restrooms, and lounge areas. Daily  $\cap$ housekeeping in conference housing rooms is not available.
- Personal Care Items Personal care items (not including toilet paper) are not provided. Please remind guests to bring 0 items such as shampoo, shaving kit, hair dryer and any other items they may need while visiting our campus. There are a few drug and grocery stores nearby (walking distance) if group members should need to purchase last minute items.
- Ice and Refrigeration There are no ice machines in the Conference Housing buildings so guests may want to bring a 0 cooler for storing ice, drinks, or food. Refrigerated storage is available for guests needing to store medication in the Conference Housing Office.
- Wake-up Calls The Conference Housing Office does not provide wake-up calls. Guests are encouraged to bring an 0 alarm clock during their stay. Guests that require a very bright light to read by may want to bring a reading lamp if they plan to do late night studying or reading.

- **Telephones** Telephones are provided in each guest room. Incoming calls can be received and local calls may be placed at no charge to the guest. Long distance calls may only be placed using a calling card or by calling toll free.
- Internet Wireless Internet access is available in some housing facilities and nearby buildings. Wireless Internet is offline from 12:00 am 7:00 am.
  Hardline, wired access is available to all of our guests for a nominal fee. You may activate your connection during the check-in process, during which you will receive a username and password. Internet connections for groups can be made in advance and, if arranged by the group contact, be placed on the group invoice. Please ensure to provide your own Ethernet cord or advise us in advance if many would be needed.

# Laundry Facilities:

- Washing machines are available in Tonopah Hall (the building where you will be checking in).
- The laundry facilities take RebelCash ONLY.
- Using a VTS (Value Transfer Station) machine found in Tonopah, Dayton, the Student Union or Student Recreation & Wellness Center, cash can be deposited on your guest access card.
- o Please be sure to load only enough for your laundry needs as cash loaded on your room key/card is not refundable.
- Laundry costs \$1.25 to wash and \$0.75 to dry.
